Cross Roads Food Pantry houses a community outreach program uniting people of all faiths to serve Monroeville residents who are in need of food and other necessities. As concerned and caring individuals, our mission is to provide nutritional food, personal care items, and social services to those who need them in order to sustain, strengthen and to educate.

In 1978, the Deacons of Cross Roads Presbyterian Church began the outreach ministry that has become the Food Pantry.

The Food Pantry moved to various areas of the building until 1996, when it became apparent that more permanent space was needed. The number of clients had increased from the original five or six families to over 130 families. The new space which is attached to the church was dedicated in September 2000.

Some 40 – 50 organizations and churches support Cross Roads Food Pantry. Temple David does a large food drive for the Food Pantry in the Spring which provides several hundred boxes of food and supplies..

Our annual Christmas Food and Toy Distribution [see photo] is an amazing part of this outreach. In addition, we are able to participate in the Giant Eagle Voucher Program, and an Easter basket distribution.

May it continue to flourish doing God's work of feeding those in need.
